Northwest Human Services Crisis and Information Hotline runs 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. The Hotline provides comprehensive services with a focus on suicide intervention and the physical and emotional well being of its clients. Additional services provided by Hotline include:

- Assistance to Pay for Prescription medication
- Single-day pass for City buses
- Personal hygiene items, as available
- Lunch packets once per month, as available
- Emergency Food Boxes, provided every 6 months
- Community Voicemail /phone number only
- Lobby Phone available for Community Voice Mail
